

The mission of *Excelencia* in Education is to accelerate Latino student success in higher education. A critical set of institutions enrolling Latino students is Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs).

Summary of the 2020-21 Emerging HSIs (eHSIs) List

HSIs are defined as accredited and degree-granting public or private nonprofit institutions of higher education with 25% or more undergraduate Hispanic full-time equivalent (FTE) student enrollment.¹ *Excelencia* developed the eHSI category—institutions with undergraduate FTE Hispanic enrollment of 15-24.9%—to track the growth of potential HSIs.

There were 393 Emerging HSIs (eHSIs) in 2020-21.

While Emerging HSIs do not have the Latino student enrollment required to meet the definition of an HSI, these institutions may soon meet the criteria as their Latino enrollment grows. The following list of Emerging HSIs was created using data from the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS).²
