Dr. Plummer first joined South Texas College (STC) in 1995 and currently serves as the Interim President. He has over twenty years of higher education experience and service in the military. Dr. Plummer has an extensive background in strategic planning, performance, and leadership that has facilitated the exploration of options to increase student enrollment, expanded comprehensive programs, fulfilled regional workforce training needs, and aided in the development of innovative ideas and methods that infuse the College's mission and vision of serving the region.



In addition to his role as Interim President, he also serves as Vice President of Information Services, Planning, Performance, and Strategic Initiatives (ISPP&SI). In his role as Vice President of ISPP&SI, he oversees all information services and operations, including information technology and security, educational technology, library services, centers for learning excellence, institutional research, strategic planning, institutional effectiveness, and accreditation.

Dr. Plummer has held numerous positions at STC over his career, including most recently Interim Executive Vice President for Educational Programming and Student Achievement. As Interim Executive Vice President for Educational Programming and Student Achievement, he oversaw both the Academic Affairs and Student Affairs/Enrollment Management Divisions in the coordination and collaboration of increasing, identifying, developing, and improving key strategic institutional initiatives. He has also served as Dean of Administrative Services, Chief Project Officer, and Director of Workforce Training. His service in the military includes an impressive 20-year career, including a combat tour in Afghanistan as an Infantry Officer. Dr. Plummer has also worked as a Senior Business Analyst for a Fortune 50 company.
