

The mission of *Excelencia* in Education is to accelerate Latino student success in higher education. A critical set of institutions enrolling Latino students is Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs).

Summary of the 2020-21 List of HSIs with Graduate Programs

In 2020-21, two-thirds of all Latino undergraduate students in higher education (66%) were enrolled in 559 institutions in the U.S. known as Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs).¹ HSIs represent 18% of all institutions of higher education. The majority of HSIs (58%) are 4-year institutions, and a smaller subset offer graduate programs.

In 2020-21, 43% of HSIs offered graduate programs (238 HSIs).

Of the 559 HSIs, 238 offered graduate degrees (148 offered doctoral degrees as the highest degree, 73 offered master's degrees, and 17 offered a post-master's certificate).

The list of institutions identified as HSIs with graduate programs in this analysis is not intended to designate eligibility for any specific program; rather, the list is meant to assist in considering and analyzing the institutions that meet the legislative definition of an HSI and offer graduate programs.² The following list of HSIs was created using data from the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS).³

¹ Summary of Title V of the Higher Education Act, as amended in 2008. To be eligible for the "Developing HSIs Program," the law further requires that an HSI have a high enrollment of needy students and low core expenditures.

² Title V, Part B of the Higher Education Opportunity Act authorizes the Promoting Postbaccalaureate Opportunities for Hispanic Americans (PPOHA) program to expand postbaccalaureate educational opportunities for, and improve the academic attainment of, Hispanic and other low-income students.

³ IPEDS is a system of surveys designed to collect institution-level data from all primary providers of postsecondary education. IPEDS is maintained at the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES), U.S. Department of Education.
