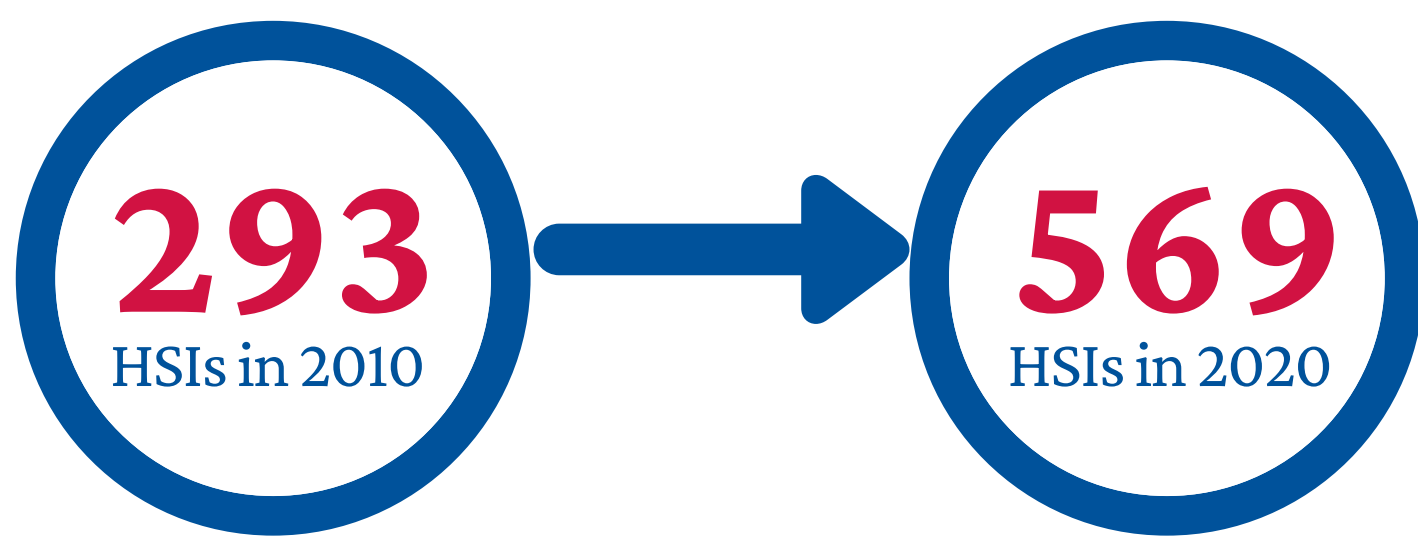


Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs)

2019-20: Fast Facts

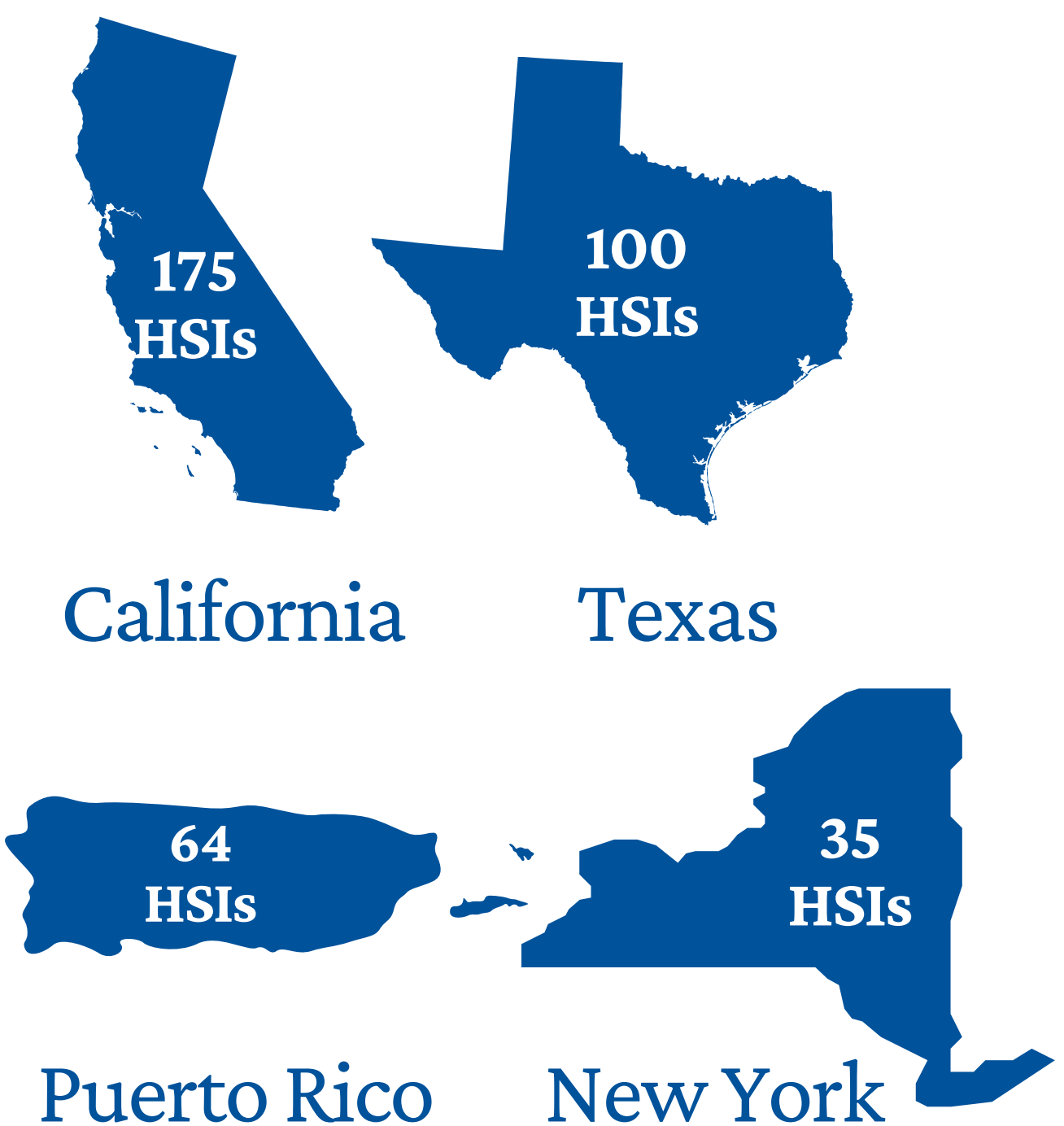
Overview

- 569** HSIs, representing **18%** of all colleges and universities.
- 67%** of all Latino undergraduates are enrolled at HSIs.
- 46%** of students enrolled at HSIs are Latino.
- 94%** increase in HSIs over the past 10 years.



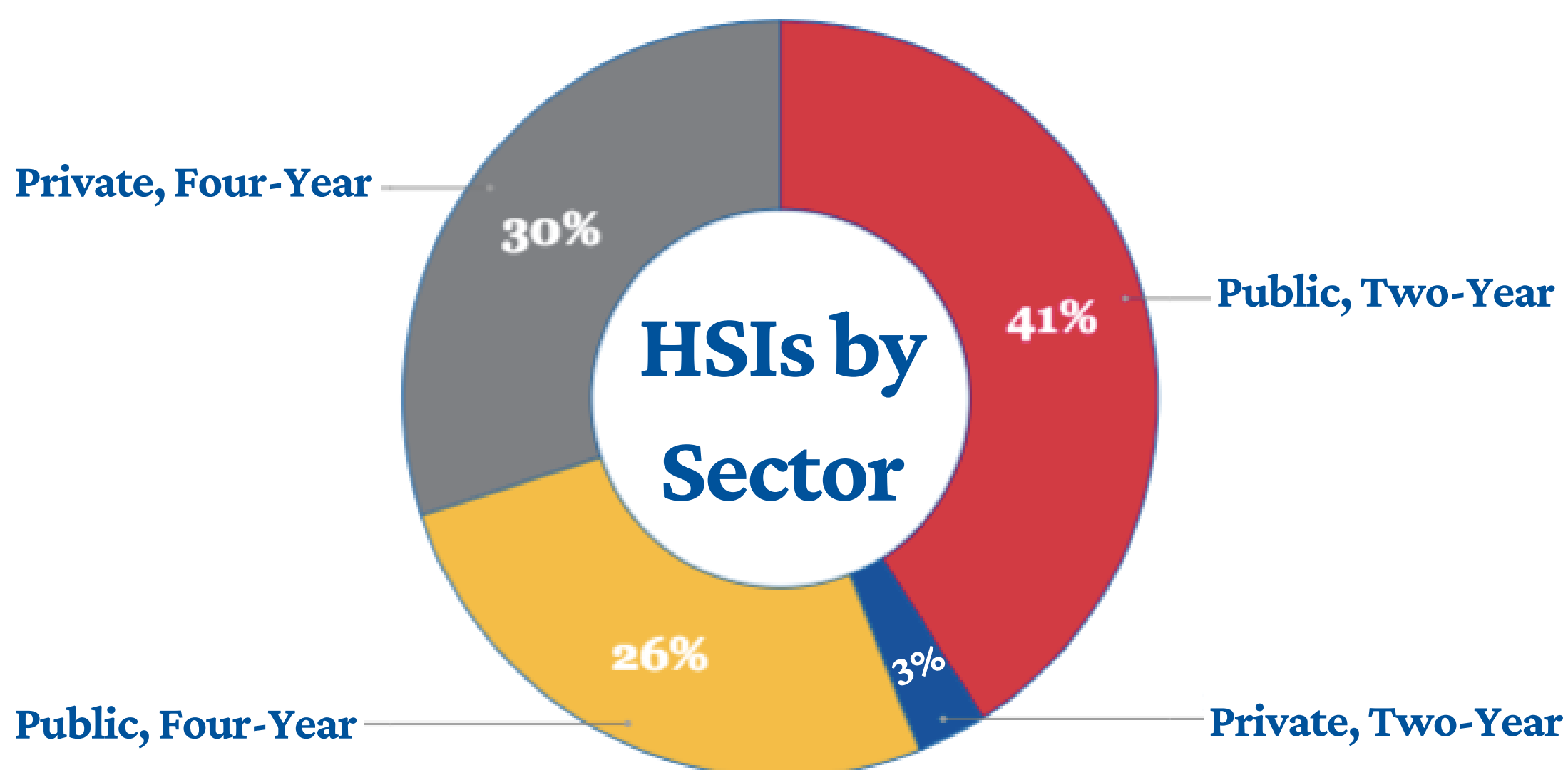
Location

While HSIs are in **30 states**, District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico, they are geographically concentrated in **4 locations**.



Sector

Overall, **56%** of HSIs are four-year institutions and **44%** are two-year institutions.

HSIs are defined in federal law as accredited and degree-granting public or private nonprofit institutions of higher education with **25 percent or more** total undergraduate Hispanic full-time equivalent (FTE) student enrollment.
