

Introduction

The mission of *Excelencia* in Education is to accelerate Latino student success while increasing all student success in higher education. A critical group of institutions enrolling and graduating Latino students are Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs).

In 2024-25, two-thirds of all Latino undergraduate students in higher education (65%) were enrolled in 631 institutions in the U.S. known as Hispanic-Serving Institutions (HSIs).¹ HSIs represent 21% of all institutions of higher education. The majority of HSIs (63%) are 4-year institutions and a smaller subset offer graduate programs.

In 2024-25, 44% of HSIs offered graduate programs (276 HSIs).

Of the 631 HSIs, 276 offered graduate degrees (184 offered doctoral degrees as the highest degree, 70 offered master's degrees, and 22 offered a post-master's certificate).

The list of institutions identified as HSIs with graduate programs in this analysis is not intended to designate eligibility for any specific program; rather, the list is meant to assist in considering and analyzing the institutions that meet the legislative definition of an HSI and offer graduate programs.² The following list of HSIs was created using data from the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS).³

Seal Certified-gHSIs

The Seal of *Excelencia* is a national certification of institutions that strive to go beyond enrollment to intentionally SERVE Latino students. In the 2024-25 academic year, 34 gHSIs were Seal certified.⁴

1.) Summary of Title V of the Higher Education Act, as amended in 2008. To be eligible for the "Developing HSIs Program," the law further requires that an HSI have a high enrollment of needy students and low core expenditures.

2.) Title V, Part B of the Higher Education Opportunity Act authorizes the Promoting Postbaccalaureate Opportunities for Hispanic Americans (PPOHA) program to expand postbaccalaureate educational opportunities for, and improve the academic attainment of, Hispanic and other low-income students.

3.) IPEDS is a system of surveys designed to collect institution-level data from all primary providers of postsecondary education. IPEDS is maintained at the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES), U.S. Department of Education.
